TEACHING CAREER IN BRIEF

I graduated from the József Attila University of Szeged in 1991 majoring in Biology and Chemistry. After graduation I took up a teaching position at my former school, Erkel Ferenc Secondary Grammar School in Gyula, where I have been teaching ever since. I also worked as a lecturer in higher education from 1993 to 2012, when I taught courses in Cell Biology and Genetics to graduate nursing students in Gyula.
